If we don't return, full Remote Booklets will be available from 12.00pm on that first Monday back. We will try and keep everything as it is now so there is no confusion. I know that Grade 2 already have activities now as well. I will say again that I know nothing about what is planned and in fact was expecting the Premier to announce his plans for school returns as promised. I am just trying to be prepared in case things don't go as we hope and we all return to start Term 4 as "normal". I will eventually get notification and when I do I will pass it on ASAP. From our point of view we will try and run everything as it is now if Remote Learning continues. I know it is getting barder and and run everything as it is now if Remote Learning continues. I know it is getting harder and from experience I know that the longer we go the harder it is to keep children engaged, but in speaking with other Principals, it is the same across the Melbourne area.

You may have heard media reports about government schools and fees. It was stated that everything was going to be free next year, including excursions, camps, sport days, absolutely everything. As usual, media reports take a little bit of truth and then explode their claims to what sells stories. If these claims were the truth, then we would either go broke, or never run excursions, camps, sport days, visiting incursions, anything. As always, fees are voluntary, but as always our fees actually directly pay for books, stationary, art materials, musical instruments, band tuition, sports equipment, computers, ICT equipment and software, photocopying, readers and parts of our Intervention and support programs. Our funding from DET barely touches any of this and there is not one cent in there for computer equipment. Each year I publish a list of what our "fees" go on and you can see they are costs we have to cover, so are something we need to bring your children the best programs and resources we can. This recent change to what schools can do to raise funds to cover basic areas of the program brought in by DET is challenging many schools in their aim to provide the best education they brought in by DET is challenging many schools in their aim to provide the best education they can for their students. I am hoping that parents will still support our school with our Voluntary Fees, as they make it possible to provide what we do for your children.

You may be aware but we were also notified that we no longer will be classified rural, so DET will deduct \$75,000 off our budget over the next 4 years. School Council is at present looking to challenge this and will be asking for your support soon. Stay tuned. Timing of these things is always interesting.

As we move further through this pandemic, please be aware of your mental well-being. We often look out for others and we ask if they are OK. Make sure you do the same for yourself. There are other shorter people in your family who depend on you, so make sure you do the things you need to do to stay well. We will all have some bad days during these times and that is OK. Making sure you can move on and up is what you may need some help with. Beyond Blue has many options that can help with this.


